Supply List:

Fabric:

- Red print 1 - Stripe Blocks and - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- Tan print 1- Stripe Blocks - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- Blue print - Stripe and Star Blocks, Setting and Corner Triangles - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
- Tan print 2 - Star Blocks - $\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
- Gingham print - Star Blocks - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x5" scrap
- Gold print - Sashing - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- Red print 2 - Cornerstones - 2"x18" scrap
- Binding - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- Backing - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
- Batting

Other:

- Thread
- Tri Recs Tools™
- 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Square ruler with diagonal line

Cutting Instructions:

Note: Fabric requirements are based on a 40 inch width of fabric (WOF). Block A and Block B are cut on the bias which will result in some fabric waste; however, you will have perfect 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.

Block A – Red, Tan, and Blue Stripe

Red Print 1

- Cut 1 – 1 7/8" x WOF

Tan Print 1

- Cut 2 – 1 7/8" x WOF

Blue Print

- Cut 2 – 3" x WOF

Block B – Red and Tan Stripe

Red Print 1

- Cut 4 – 1 7/8" x 20"

Tan Print 1

- Cut 3 – 1 7/8" x 20"

Star Block

Blue Print

- Cut 1 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20. Sub cut 16 triangles (8 pairs) using the Recs Tool™. Refer to the Recs cutting instructions in the pattern.

Tan Print 2

- Cut 1 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sub cut 8 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 8 triangles using the Tri Tool™. Refer to the Tri cutting instructions in the pattern.

Gingham Print

- Cut 2 – 2½” x 2½” squares

Sashing

Gold Print

- Cut 3 – 2” x WOF. Sub cut into 8 - 12½” segments.

Cornerstones

Red Print 2

- Cut 7 – 2” squares

Setting Triangles and Corner Triangles

Blue Print

- Cut 1 – 15” square for setting triangles. Cut square in half diagonally.
- Cut 2 – 12” squares for corner triangles. Cut each square in half diagonally.

Sewing Instructions:

Adjust the number of blocks needed as follows:

- Block A – Make 4 blocks
- Block B – Make 2 blocks
- Star Block – Make 2 blocks
- Star and Stripes Blocks – Make 2 blocks

Refer to the sewing instructions in the pattern to complete the quilt.
